Engaging Leaders in Delivering the Vision

Having agreed upon an ambitious long term vision, ICE needed to focus their 2008 senior manager conference on how to 'make that vision a reality'.

HarknessKennett provided both consultancy and interim support to Graham Sibley, Group Head of Communications to develop the structure and content for a conference that would engage the whole of the senior team in their role in delivering the vision. The conference also aimed to equip the senior team to engage their own teams in delivering the vision.

The conference was designed as a highly interactive and involving two days that focused senior managers on tackling practical issues. Many of the conference sessions were based on discussion, debate and challenges that the managers worked through in groups to reach practical outcomes.
